



SEEKING NOMINATIONS FOR THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

As a member driven organization, it is important for the PRCA to best represent its members and the industry by holding an election of members to the organizations' Board of Directors. The PRCA's Board of Directors is responsible for the operation of the organization, budgeting, and secretariat duties for the ANSI/PRCA American National Safety Standards. The PRCA's Board of Directors is now conducting the 2019 election of three (3) board members, and we are asking the membership to nominate any suitable candidates. PRCA members may nominate a particular PRCA member, or can self-nominate.

The following are qualifications to serve on the Board of Directors:

- 1) Candidate must be a current PRCA member listed in good standing.
- 2) Candidate must have been a PRCA member for a period of at least one year.
- 3) Candidate must have demonstrated public support for the PRCA in the industry.
- 4) Candidate must execute and comply with Board of Directors commitment form.
- 5) Candidate must read and comply with current PRCA by-laws.
- 6) Candidates for Director-At-Large positions must be a regular or international member in the same membership classification as those whom they seek to represent (individual or organizational members).

**Nominations deadline for the Board of Directors election is
Monday December 10th, 2018 at 5 pm Eastern Time**

Nominees must submit the following information: name, contact information, email, phone, and any other relevant information regarding their professional industry service and knowledge.

A brief statement of the candidate's interest in serving on the Board of Directors.

A brief statement of the candidate's qualifications and background in the industry.

Declaration of their membership status: either individual or organizational member.

Announcement of candidate's is made shortly after. Elected board members begin service January 2019.
