This is a Level 1 Low or High* Challenge Ropes Course Facilitator training and certification process.

*While we are offering both tracks, you will only be able to take ONE of these (NOT BOTH) during this workshop. Please make a selection below.

This means you are extremely unlikely to complete the certification process while you are with us but we will assist you in **knowing** the process, **starting it**, and **connecting** you all the way to completion.

NOTE: You can choose to come to Tampa at the conference Friday, 3/6, or Saturday, 3/7 to continue to get reviewed for skills verification, at no extra cost, and to further your process completion! We will work with you and your home organization (if you have one), in planning for the interim and follow-up training/"internship".
