## **SAFETY ALERT –RECALL ISC UltraLink Units Stop Use Immediately**

PRCA Safety Alert / Technical Advisory Committee:

The purpose of the PRCA safety alerts and technical advisories is to disseminate current and recently acquired information to the industry which will aid in the prevention of accidents on ropes courses, canopy tours, aerial adventure parks and zip line tours. Where possible the PRCA will provide unbiased information related to the incidents / events, materials involved and if known root causes of accidents or near misses. When possible, the PRCA Safety Alert / Technical Advisory Committee will make appropriate contacts as necessary, but the committee does not intend to perform in depth investigations into incidents, we rely upon the information provided by manufacturers, our members, members of the industry and other industry associations, such as the European Ropes Course Association and YOU.

### **Background:**

On March 13, 2023 ISC issued a request for the immediate stop use and recall of the ISC UltraLink. The PRCA was notified of this recall through the manufacturer.

### **Issue:**

The ISC UltraLink has a push button release and during initial uses it was determined that the release button could be contacted by rope twists or other items and possibly depressed releasing the pin. There were no near misses or injuries. ISC issued an immediate recall. The recall affects recall applies to all units in circulation from the 28th of February 2023 through the 13th of March 2023. Batch numbers include: LK100: 168276, 168153, 166671, 167961 LK101: 167962, 166675, 168231, 168155, 168277.
